The Mavrovo National Park is one of the oldest national parks in Europe. Known for its rich biodiversity and attractive natural amenitiesspacious beech forests, alpine meadows, virgin rivers and streams. Huge variety of species such as the rare species of trout, wolves, bears and otters live in the park. One kind is still special - Balkan lynx (Lynx lynx balcanicus)critically endangered subspecies of the Eurasian lynx.

The park is home to more than 1000 different plant species. The natural values of the park belong to all of us: campers, hikers, nature lovers, researchers and "residents" of the park, hence our shared duty to preserve...

However, the Mavrovo National Park is under threat. Two large scale hydropower plants are projected, supported by the EBRD (European Bank for Reconstruction and Development) and the World Bank. Would these projects harm nature or would they even threaten the national park status? What is the future of Mavrovo National Park?
