




Albanian rivers

- mostly untouched or near natural
- ☐ Most part of Albanian rivers (total 3,118 km) inherited untouched;
- ☐ Mostly near natural state (2,090 km, or 67%), or slightly to moderately modified (636 km, or 21%);
- □ Hence, their conservation value within Natura 2000 was considered very high (2209 km, or 71%), or high (518 km, or 17%) (Schwarz, 2012).







Why Vjosa/Aoos River?

- ☐ Vjosa/Aoos is the biggest river of Albania after Drini;
- ☐ Vjosa is the last free flowing river in Europe, outside Russia;
- ☐ Considered a riverine ecosystem of European significance.



















































